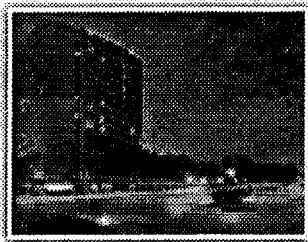

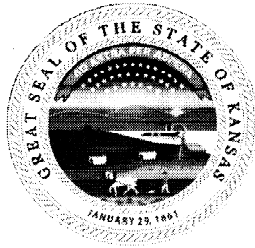


Ewing & Muriel Kauffman
