

## **CLYDE W. WOOTEN October 5, 1916 - September 2, 2004**

Born in Wilma, Arkansas. He married Ruth E. Williams and was married for 55 years until her death. Clyde earned his R.O.T.C. commission at the University of Arkansas and served 30 years in the United States Air Force, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel. He lived in Colorado Springs for 36 years.

He was a veteran of World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. Awards included 3 Bronze Stars, the Joint Service Commendation and Meritorious Service medals along with the Vietnam Medal of Honor 1st class with numerous campaign ribbons.

Clyde served 75 years in the Boy Scouts. He earned the Silver Antelope, Silver Beaver, 4 Bead Wood Badger, Good Shepherd Award, James West Fellow National Endowment Award and Vigil OA. He, his son and grandson were Eagle Scouts.

Clyde is survived by his son, grandson and granddaughter.
